A Budapesti Francia Intézet és a Magyarországi Francia Nagykövetség szervezésében "Jövőkép a fenntartható városokról" című kerekasztal-beszélgetésre kerül sor, **2023. november 15-én, szerdán 17:30 és 19:30** között a **Francia Intézet előadótermében** (1011 Budapest, Fő utca 17.).

Az eseményen Párizsból és Budapestről érkező szakértők ismertetik, hogy milyen kulcsfontosságú önkormányzati intézkedéseket hoztak városaik zölddé és fenntarthatóvá tétele érdekében. Ezt követően civil szervezetek képviselőinek részvételével vitára kerül sor a mai környezeti kihívásoknak megfelelő hatékony fenntarthatósági politika kérdéseket illetően, továbbá városi környezetben megvalósítható konkrét ökológiai kezdeményezésekről is hallhatunk.

III. STOA Workshop on 'Neurotechnology and neurorights - Privacy's last frontier'

Following neurotechnology governance efforts from governmental, intergovernmental, and non-governmental institutions to tackle new concerns in the field, the current round table is dedicated to discuss the open issues and the future of neurorights. It will address questions such as: What are the gaps in existing legislation of human rights? Can the EU's privacy framework, including the EU AI act, accommodate neurorights? Can "cognitive liberty" be enshrined as a fundamental human right? How can we achieve responsible innovation in neurotechnology? etc.

The workshop will be streamed and held in English, moreover, it welcomes those who are interested in the field.

IV. EARMA Mentorship Scheme

The EARMA Mentorship Scheme pilot was launched October 30, 2023. The scheme is designed to support early career stage colleagues who are new to research management. This will be facilitated through targeted, regular and informal discussions on pre-determined (or pre-defined) topics proposed by mentees. Topics will be agreed with more senior or experienced colleagues who will perform the mentoring role. The entire process will be conducted within a confidential and professional environment.

As part of the pilot, there will be appointed a total of twenty participants: ten to act as mentors and ten to act as mentees. The aim of the mentorship is to create ten pairs of participants using the criteria set out below. Each pair will work together to develop their individual activity plan, outlining their ambitions for the duration of the programme. The pairing will be based on criteria such as number of years in the profession, topic of expertise and desired personal development etc.

The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) invited the ISC to put forward nominations of experts to participate in the Scoping Meeting for the IPCC Special Report on Climate Change and Cities. The meeting to discuss the draft outline will be held in 2024. The draft outline will be submitted to the panel for approval before the authors teams can be selected to work on the report. Participants in the Scoping Meeting should have expertise in biophysical, impacts and risks, energy and emission, sectoral development, adaptation, mitigation and responses to losses and damages among others.

Nominated experts may be academics, policy experts and/or practitioners who come from qualified national, regional and international scientific organizations, centres of excellence and institutions.
